Ingeborg Lüscher at White Rainbow Gallery, London

“It's 1 o'clock and the bell tolls 8 times,” the first UK solo show by Swiss artist Ingeborg Lüscher will run through January 21, 2017, at White Rainbow gallery, London.

Lüscher's work centers on everyday objects, experiences, and impressions drawn from her immediate environment. Besides objects and installations, her practice has also yielded photography, paintings, and texts. Since the 1990s, she has also created video art.

The selection of works on display range from paintings to sculptures made with sulphur and ash. This was the artist's main production during the late Eighties and early Nineties. Lüscher frequently draws from the natural world, and, in this exhibition, the artist seeks to conjure the physical sensation of fire without experiencing it visually.
